

What is Mökki db?

Mökki db (short for decibel) is a range of acoustically-treated, modular buildings suitable for internal use. They offer quiet spaces in which to work or meet within noisy, open-plan environments like offices, warehouses, factories, schools, universities, healthcare buildings or co-working spaces.

What makes the Mökki db unique?

Sustainability: Mökki dbs are the only office pods that we know of that are made from fully sustainable and healthy materials. Most on the market are constructed much like caravans using plastic, carpet and glass. Few originate in the UK. Mökki dbs are made nearly entirely from FSC-accredited, sustainable timber - a completely renewable resource. All our materials have zero formaldehyde content and our finishes (Osmo) have super-low VOC content.

Value: most available office pods of a similar size cost upwards of £15k and often there are numerous hidden extras.

What is the function of the available models?

Mökki dbs are available in 2 basic models called 'Work' and 'Meet'. Our 'Work' model is designed as a private work or teaching space for 1 or 2 people. Our 'Meet' model is designed to accommodate meetings of between 2 and 6 people. Both can be fitted with built-in birch plywood benches and desks.

What do you mean by modular?

Each model is available in 2 sizes - Large and Compact. These correspond exactly to the size of 1 or 2 standard plywood sheets - either 1.22m x 2.44m or 2.44m x 2.44m. The units can be lined up, rotated or stacked together in multiple layouts to suit different environments and needs.

How are Mökki dbs ventilated?

The roofs of our buildings are fitted with an air intake and extract in opposite corners. In each case the air has to pass through a sound baffle to prevent acoustic transfer. The extract is boosted by a near-silent fan.

How sound-proof are Mökki dbs?

The plywood and OSB that we use is 18mm thick and all our panels are fully filled with acoustic insulation. The windows are double-glazed and the door has a 40mm thick solid core. When stacking Mökki dbs side by side we leave a 20mm gap to prevent noise transfer between units.

What about impact sound through the floor?

We offer a range of bases to suit different scenarios. If you have a suitable, flat floor (like carpet in an office) and are not worried about acoustic transfer to rooms below then we don't need a base at all. This is particularly suitable where flush wheelchair access is required. Moving up from that we can use a single layer of 18mm OSB or a double or even triple layer with resilient underlay between the sheets. If your floor is uneven or if thermal insulation is a concern (say you are in an un-insulated warehouse space) then we can use fully insulated floor panels similar to the ones we use for our garden buildings.

How do the electrics work in a Mökki db?

Because we frequently install far afield and electrical systems within existing buildings are all different we only undertake what's called 'first-fix' electrics. This means that we run cables around undertakings to pre-cut socket holes. It is then up to a local electrician to wire the building back to a suitable supply, install the sockets and commission. Our team includes qualified electricians so we may be able to undertake this work by agreement if you are local (to Devon!).

What if there are access restrictions?

As with our garden studios, our buildings come in panel form so we can install in nearly all locations - eg up flights of stairs, through narrow doorways etc. Mökki dbs are built from the inside which means that they can be positioned directly adjacent to each other and very close to existing walls.

How long do Mökki dbs take to build?

Typically the building of a single large Mökki db takes less than a day on site.

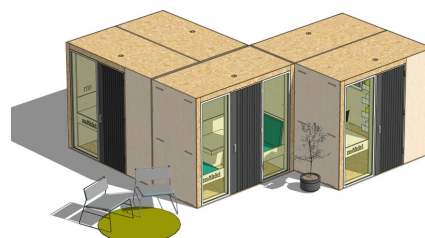
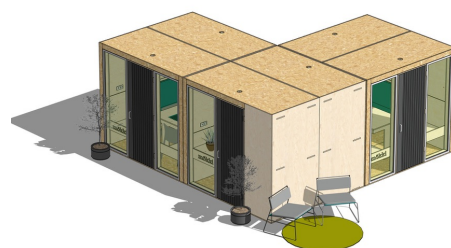
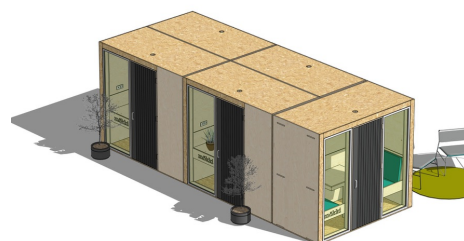
Mökki db Large - 2.44m x 2.44m



Mökki db Compact - 1.22m x 2.44m

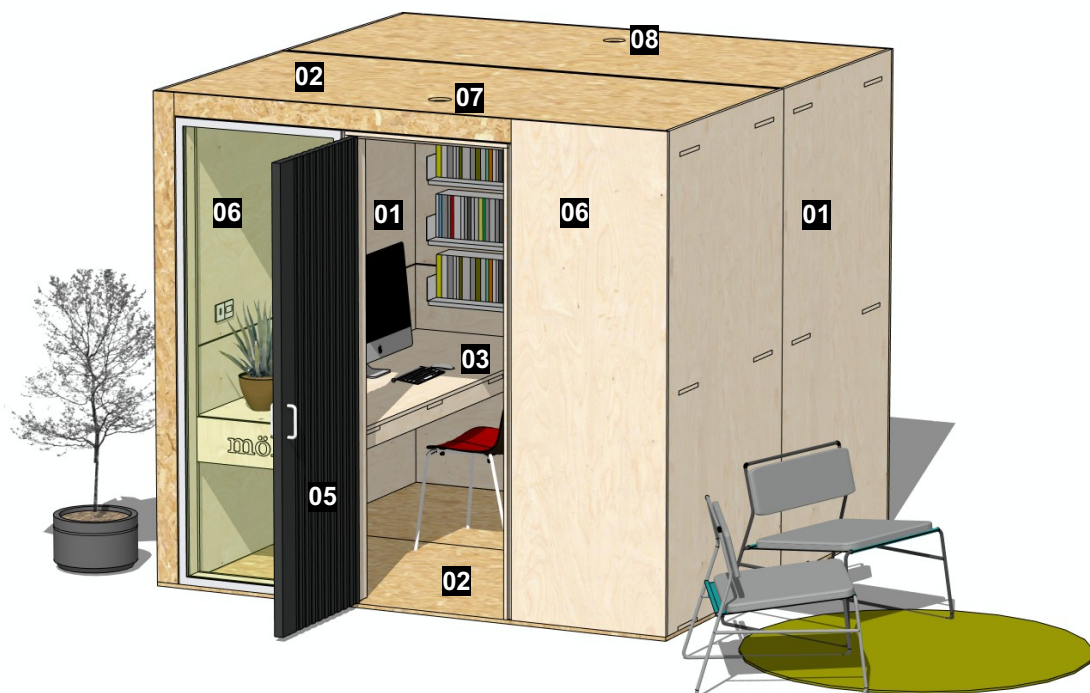

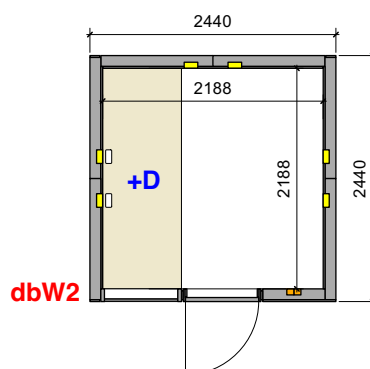
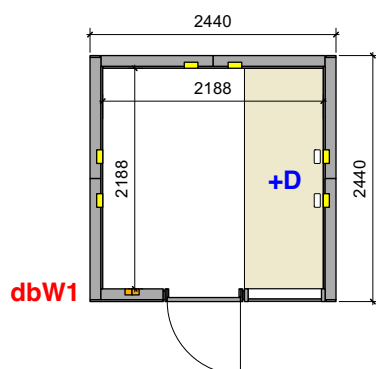






- 01 - 18mm thick CNC-cut spruce plywood panel fully filled with Earthwool acoustic insulation.
- 02 - 18mm thick CNC-cut OSB Zero (zero formaldehyde content).
- 03 - 18mm thick CNC-cut birch plywood desk finished in Osmo poly x oil (low VOC).
- 04 - 18mm thick CNC-cut birch plywood bench finished in Osmo poly x oil (low VOC). Cushions not included.
- 05 - FSC certified solid ash door (40mm thick) prefinished in black.
- 06 - Double-glazed, toughened glass window - CNC-cut spruce plywood with mill finish aluminium angle frame.
- 07 - air intake (through sound baffle).
- 08 - air extract (through sound baffle).

Payment Stages
